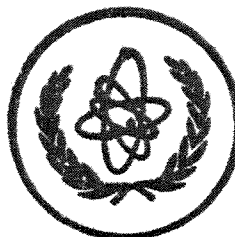
Based on the proposals received from some of the intergovernmental organizations and the non-governmental organizations that attended the briefing during the fiftieth regular session of the IAEA General Conference last year (i.e. the International Nuclear Energy Academy (INEA), European Nuclear Society (ENS), Arab Atomic Energy Agency (AAEA), Pacific Nuclear Council (PNC), International Organization for Standardization (ISO)), the Secretariat suggests the following broad topics to be discussed during this year's meeting:

- Nuclear energy as an option towards sustainable development,
- Education and public information in nuclear energy,
- Harmonization of codes and standards for the construction of nuclear power plants (NPPs).

Similar to the practice followed last year, this year the Secretariat would like to invite again those intergovernmental organizations and the non-governmental organizations that came forward with their proposals to make short presentations, with each presentation lasting a maximum of 10 minutes, which would be followed by general discussions with the other organizations and with relevant IAEA staff. No formal IAEA presentations are foreseen.

Other intergovernmental organizations and the non-governmental organizations that wish to make presentations on the above mentioned topics or suggest other topics to be discussed during this year's meeting, are requested to inform the Secretariat by **Friday, 18 May 2007**.

The Secretariat of the International Atomic Energy Agency avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the intergovernmental organizations and the non-governmental organizations the assurances of its highest consideration.
