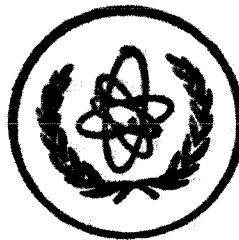

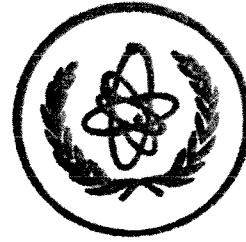
The Secretariat of the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) presents its compliments to the Ministries of Foreign Affairs of its Member States and has the honour to request that they draw the attention of the appropriate governmental authorities to the Scientific Forum, which will be held during the fifty-third regular session of the General Conference. The theme of the Forum will be **Energy for Development** and it will take place on 15 and 16 September 2009 at the Vienna International Centre (VIC), in parallel to the formal proceedings of the General Conference. There will be four sessions on the following topics: **Energy for Development — The Issues, Energy Demand, Energy Supply, and International Institutional Implications.**

The **first** session is expected to review the principal issues surrounding energy for development, the lack of access to modern energy services in many parts of the world and the nature of international assistance for energy for development. The **second** session will discuss the essential drivers of energy demand, the prospects for energy efficiency improvements in various end-use sectors and present several demand scenarios. The **third** session will focus on energy resource availability and supply technology options — renewables, fossil and nuclear. The **fourth** session will explore the role of international organizations in advancing energy for development.

Governments to which this note is addressed are invited to designate representatives for participation in the Forum. The IAEA encourages Member States to include in their delegations representatives from organizations dealing with the issues mentioned above. The Secretariat would be grateful if the attached Tentative Programme and Participation Form could be brought to the attention of the authorities, institutions and persons that might be interested.
